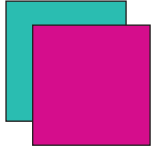


# Curiouser QAL Block 12 - Diagonals

All seam allowances are scant 0.25", and the finished square will measure 12.5"

## Materials



2 squares (11 7/8" x 11 7/8")  
in contrasting fabrics

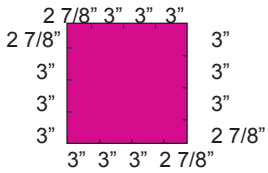


2 x border rectangles (2.5" x 10" deliberately larger than needed)



2 x border rectangles (2.5" x 13" deliberately larger than needed)

## Instructions



On the WS of the fabric, mark along the edges  
of one of the squares, as shown.



Join the markings to give parallel diagonal lines  
across the square.



Place the marked square over the second  
square and carefully cut along the marked  
lines using your rotary cutter.



Match alternating strips, so that when they are  
sewn together they will make a diagonally  
striped square. Sew the pairs of strips together.



Repeat with the remaining strips. Take care  
not to stretch the diagonal pieces.



Press all of the seams, and then sew the four pairs  
of strips together. Repeat for the second block.

Press the blocks, and trim them to square, 9.5".



Finally, add borders as described in the instructions for Block 2, and trim to 12.5" square.
